## 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Pleasant Hill Lanes Youth Open Singles Tournament Rules and Regulations:

- 1. This tournament is certified by the USBC and all USBC tournament rules and regulations will govern. All bowlers must be sanctioned and participating in a sanctioned youth league.
- 2. Awards: 2 scholarship winners in each division guaranteed. Each Champion will receive a minimum of a \$150 scholarship and Trophy. Runner- ups will receive a minimum of \$50 scholarship each. Additional places may be awarded based on entries. ALL scholarships will be managed by the USBC SMART Program.
- 3. Averages used will be as of March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 with 18 or more games bowled. All others MUST bowl scratch. Bowlers who bowl in more than one league must list all league averages and provide average sheets for all leagues. *No entries accepted without payment and average sheets.*
- 4. Division classifications are based on average. Male and female athletes will compete in the same division.
- 5. Handicap: Handicap will be based on 90% of 230 in all divisions.
- 6. All errors must be reported within 72 hours. The tournament manager will be the final authority unless a written appeal is filed in accordance to USBC rule 329. Errors in handicap or division will be automatically corrected.
- 7. Check in at the tournament desk ½ hour prior to starting time. Bowlers can only enter once. Late bowlers receive zero (0) for frames missed.
- 8. NO SMOKING, NO EATING OR DRINKING IN THE BOWLING ENCLOSURE. NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES will be allowed by any athlete at any time once tournament play begins. Tournament officials and bowlers ONLY allowed in bowling enclosure... no exceptions.
- 9. Dress Code: Participants in the Tournament must be neat in appearance and meet the following dress code rules:
  - a. Shirts Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar similar to golf or polo shirts. (Tee-shirts from a youth bowling program or USBC bowling shirts are acceptable) Shirts must cover the entire midriff area or be tucked in.
  - b. Shorts and Skirts are allowed but must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
  - c. Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, and gambling or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed.
  - d. Pants must be worn at the waist or held there with a belt. Torn or cut jeans will not be allowed.
  - e. No hats of any kind are permitted. (Unless for religious reasons)
  - f. All clothing apparel must be the correct clothing size. (Ex; if wear med shirt do not wear xxxl shirt) Bowlers will be required to change if tournament officials deem attire inappropriate. Tournament official's decision will be final.
- 10. The penalty for any infraction is disqualification from the tournament.
- 11. Ties:
  - a. For the 134 & under division: Tie for 1st or 2nd Place (if applicable) will result in a 1 game roll-off. Ties for non-championship positions will split respective scholarship prize(s).
  - b. For 135-179 division and 180 & over: Tie for the advancement into the stepladder finals and during the stepladder will result in a 1 game roll-off. All other ties will split the respective scholarship prize(s).
- 12. Optional Scratch side tournament. Sum of games 2, 3, and 4. Highest scratch series amongst those who entered will win 100% of collected monies as scholarship prize. Must paid \$10 entry fee before game 1 starts. Ties for 1<sup>st</sup> will split the prize.
